Fees Per Dog

\$42 for 2 Flyers

\$28 for 1 Flyer, one series all dead birds

\$15 for 0 Flyers, dead birds in both series

- Limit of 2 Flyers per dog
- Limit of 3 dogs per handler
- Limit of 70 dogs or 100 ducks (whichever comes first)

All costs and fees are calculated 'per dog'. They include the cost of birds/delivery, ammo, poppers and \$5 per dog CRTA fee.

We are trying to create a test atmosphere with the big guns / live birds for breaking dogs and dogs that need more exposure to fresh killed/live ducks.

Everyone is expected to help out - in the field, haul birds out to stations, gun (shoot birds), marshal or "judge". Plan arrive at 8 am and spend the entire day.

Submission of entry includes acknowledgement that handlers will help with the moving of birds and equipment at the end of each series, including clean-up and delivering equipment to the trailer at the end of the day.

There will be **2 groups** at each 'stake': one **Running** dogs and the other **Working**/helping. Then they will trade-off during the 'gun change'. You will stay with your group for the day.

We should easily get in 2 series per group. There will be 3 gun stations in the field for each series.

Group 1 – Puppy / Beginning / Jr / WC/X / Senior / (Master) (straight forward set-ups)

Group 2 - Senior/Master (more cover/complex set-ups and running blinds - one per series).

In order to make the groups more or less equal in size/time there will be some overlap in levels.

There may be a few Senior or Master level dogs in Group 1.

Those dogs **will** get to run a blind.

Norcal's supply of ducks will be used to start the day at the dead bird stations.

This supply will need to be replenished from the first flyer everyone buys, up to 30 birds. Beyond that number, the remainder will be available for purchase at \$5 each. (This will help defray the actual purchase cost to the club for these birds saved from our hunt test.)
